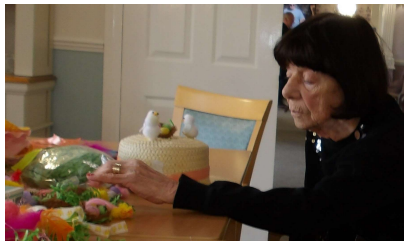

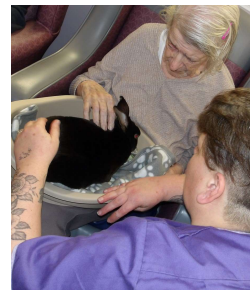
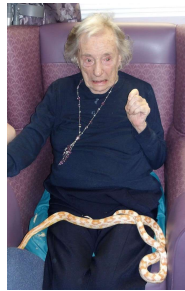


Easter Fun (with a visit from the Bunny)

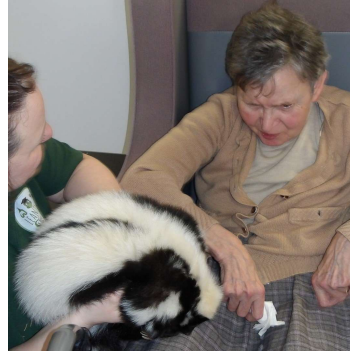
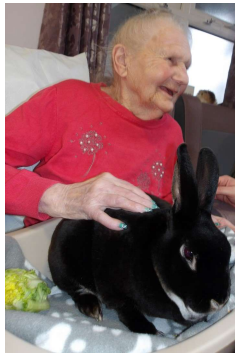
