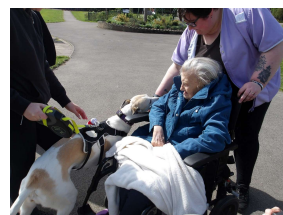


Meadowhall Shopping Trip

We enjoyed a lovely look around the shops, had a bit of fun trying on some clothes and then enjoyed a well deserved stop for Lunch and a drink.

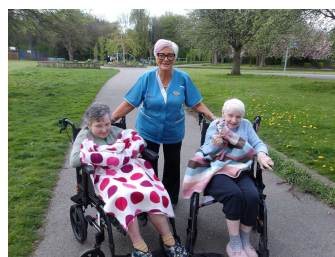


Ecclesfield Park Trips

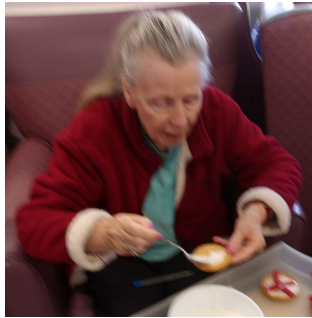

Crucible Theatre

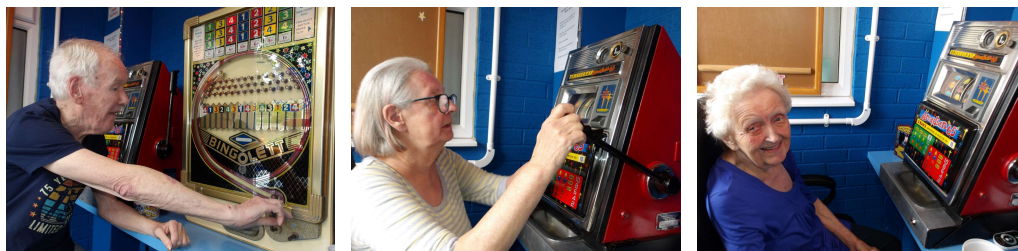
